

## **FY 2010 Authorization Issues**

*Note: The following list is provided for your information. In the event that authorizing legislation is not enacted in a timely manner, these items will allow either for the continuation of programs that will be funded in the CR or for other legislative fixes. Unless specified otherwise, the authority extensions are for programs that will expire on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and are needed over roughly the first three months of the fiscal year (through December 24<sup>th</sup>). A broader discussion will be required if a CR remains in effect beyond this timeframe.*
